

b) Here again, 94 per cent had heard of the claim that Palestinians want and are able to live with Palestinian Jews under a democratic Palestinian state; while 6.0 per cent had not heard of that claim.

This claim did not convince as many Americans as the first claim. 20.0 per cent were not convinced of the second claim, compared to 15.0 per cent who were not convinced of the first claim. 33.0 per cent were convinced of the second claim, compared to 45.0 per cent who were convinced of the first claim. 42.0 per cent were not sure whether the Palestinians meant their claim that they want a democratic Palestinian state or not. (See Table 10b below.)
