

of them said that his interest in the Palestine problem would cease. 8 per cent gave no answer. (See Table 12a.)

Also 90.0 per cent said they would care to read any publications about the Palestine problem after they go back home. 6 per cent said they might care to read such publications. No one said he would not care to read such publications, and 4.0 per cent said they did not know whether they would care to read any publications about the Palestine problem or not. (See Table 12b.)

Conclusion

In general, all adult Americans who reside in Lebanon will keep their interest in the Palestine problem after they go back home, and they will care about reading any publications about the Palestine problem when they are home for good.
